Re: Export of lavender, rosemary and olive plants from Israel to the UK, and Plant Health Declarations

Dear Mr. Bishop,

I shall open by wishing you and your colleagues at DEFRA a peaceful and blissful new year.

This letter replies to your letter dated 22 December 2023, which concerned a consignment of rosemary and lavender rooted cuttings exported from Israel, which was held in the UK due a missing pre-declaration from Israel.

I would like to thank you for your clarification of the requirement for early provision of a list of pest free places of production (PFPPs) for the export of *Lavandula* sp. (lavender), *Salvia rosmarinus* (rosemary) and *Olea europaea* (olive) plants from Israel.

Indeed, as you mentioned in your letter, we export these products to the UK under options 4 (b) (lavender, rosemary) and 5 (b) (olive). This means that export is from the area in Israel, which is outside the limited area of *Xylella fastidiosa* infestation, and from places of production which are officially approved and inspected by PPIS for freedom from *X. fastidiosa*, and that the plant consignments are inspected prior to export.

We regret that the list of PFPPs has not been communicated to DEFRA in advance, and appreciate the opportunity to do so now. Please see in the table below, the list of PFPPs that export lavender, rosemary and olive plants from Israel to the UK.
