In entry 4E, for “*subsignarius*” substitute with “*subsignaria* (Hübner)”.

After entry 5ZA, insert “5ZAA. *Homona magnanima* Dyakonov [HOMOMA]”

ANNEX 7

List of plants, plant products and other objects originating from third countries and the corresponding special requirements for their introduction into Great Britain

PART A - Plants, plant products and other objects originating in third countries which may only be introduced into Great Britain if special requirements are met

Amend entry 38:

In column 3, in (a) delete “*Helicoverpa armigera* (Hübner) and”.

In (b), delete “*Helicoverpa armigera* (Hübner) or”.

In (c), for “those pests” substitute with “the pest”.

Then insert a new entry – entry 58A:

Plants, other than seeds, pollen and plants in tissue culture, of <i>Pinus</i> spp.	Any third country	The plants must be accompanied by an official statement that the plants have: (a) been grown throughout their life in a country where <i>Toumeyella parvicornis</i> (Cockerell) is known not to occur,

(b) i) been grown throughout their life in an area* established by the national plant protection organisation in accordance with ISPM4 as an area that is free from *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell) and

ii) that the plants have been inspected immediately prior to export and found free from *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell), or

(c) been grown during a period of at least one year prior to export, or, in the case of plants younger than one year, throughout their life, in a place of production:

- i. which has been established by the national plant protection organisation in accordance with ISPM10 as a place of production that is free from *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell),
 - ii. which is registered and supervised by the national plant protection organisation in the country of origin,
 - iii. which has been subjected annually to two official inspections for any signs of *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell) carried out at appropriate times, and
 - iv. within which the plants have been grown in a site with complete physical protection against the introduction of *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell) and

- v. immediately prior to export, the plants have been subjected to a meticulous inspection for the presence of *Toumeyella parvicornis* (Cockerell).

*The name of the area(s) must be included in the phytosanitary certificate under the heading "Additional declaration".

Amend entry 109:

In column 2, add "Armenia," before the existing text.

Amend entry 110:

Amend entry 115:

In column 2, delete "Armenia,".

PART B - Plants, plant products and other objects originating in third countries which are subject to emergency measures and may only be introduced into Great Britain if special requirements are met

Amend entry 2:

In column 3, in (b) add "*" after the first "area".

In (c), delete "*" after "area".

ANNEX 11

List of plants, plant products and other objects and the respective third countries of origin or dispatch in respect of which phytosanitary certificates are required

PART A - List of plants, plant products and other objects and the respective third countries of origin or dispatch, which may not be introduced into Great Britain unless they are accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, as referred to in Article 72(1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/2031

Amend entry 45:

In column 3, delete "Armenia,".

Amend entry 45A:
