

National Register of Producers of Seeds and Plants of Spain Guidance

In order to meet the imports requirements for *Xylella fastidiosa*-host plant material, Spain has provided the UKNPPO as advance notification, access to the National Register of Producers of Seeds and Plants of Spain (please see below).

Xylella hosts from Spain will need to include in the phytosanitary certificate the correct additional declaration and when pre-notification by the exporting country is required, the exporter details will be cross-checked against the Spanish Register. PHSI inspectors will be able to confirm statements in the phytosanitary certificate that can only be used if pre-notified to the UKNPPO referred in Annex 7B options 'b' and 'c', for Part B 4 and 5: details of the place(s) of production and details of the site(s) of production.



- The producer needs to appear on the register, and it does not need to declare any specific groups of plants as being approved. So, provided the place of production is found in the database and the phytosanitary certificate has the correct additional declarations, then the consignment is considered as meeting our requirements.
